With an insatiable curiosity for color, Tadashi Asoma's paintings reveal a remarkably adept portrayal of the changes of the seasons. His sudden bursts of pure brilliant color, with splendid variations of brushstroke and tone, exemplify his natural originality and closeness with nature. The colors are luminously conceived for the landscape and the lightly feathered textures translate admirably to the glory and jubilant majesty of nature herself.

Asoma was born in Japan in 1923 and at the age of 35 he was awarded a scholarship from the Japanese government to study painting in Paris. After his studies, he visited the United States and was fascinated with the American style of painting during that period. He moved to New York with his family where he studied and painted for three years before returning to Japan. It wasn't until 1961 that he returned to New York with his family and settled in the East Village. During the day he was involved at the Art Student's League painting and studying, while at night he supported his family by working in a restaurant. The seventies were a time of solitude for Asoma, yet, ironically a time he believes connected him deeply with nature. He moved to a little village named Garrison located about forty miles north of Manhattan, and it was Garrison that would become a predominate inspiration for his work. The majority of Asoma's paintings were produced while he resided in the United States.

Now in his mid 80's, Asoma has been lauded by many critics and collectors of contemporary art as 'The Prophet of Color'. He has participated in one-man and group exhibitions throughout the world, including New York, Palm Beach, San Francisco, Tokyo, Switzerland and Germany. His work is included in many public and private collections and can be found in numerous museums around the world.
